


STUDENT ONLINE ASSESSMENT

Our admissions process prioritizes getting to know each student as an individual—their personality, interests, and the unique ways they think. Through the Student Online Assessment, students can share who they are in their own words, providing authentic insights for our Admissions Committee. They'll respond to three video questions, and two written questions. The process takes about 30-40 minutes on average. The assessment can be completed anywhere a student has internet, and at any time. We'll share the assessment with all applicants in 'applied' status in Ravenna on October 17th. Note to Parents/Guardians

The online assessment is an excellent way for us to get to know them directly from them in their own words and voice. While there is no 'rule' against you staying close by in the room when your student completes the assessment, please consider if you will be a calming presence in the room, or if you will make them nervous.

When the leaves start to turn, and the 3 pm traffic starts again, it means two things: fall is in the air, and school has begun again. At this time of year, it's easy to get caught up in so many things; college applications, pre-holiday planning, and the rush to enjoy those last days of sun before the "big gray" hits.

It's also time for admissions season to kick off, and we know that families may begin to feel pressure to start the application process and plan the next four to eight years of their student's lives.
