**1. APG President:**

- May 21<sup>st</sup>: Final APG General Meeting will be in-person

**2. EPS Administration:**

- Tariffs are impacting various aspects of school operations / administrations, e.g. ordering next year's laptops now to get ahead of price hikes. We'll have to monitor the situation and our APG budget for next year.
- This week, we have final interview rounds for the EICL Director position. EPS has narrowed it down to four highly-qualified finalists.
- Linbrook building acquisition update:
  - o Building 12 – Is available for lease now and has been remodeled.
  - o Building 10 – Will be likely up for lease next year
  - o Building 5 – Needs some updates. We'll have environmental classrooms and a lab here so kids will have space to work on the creek.
  - o Building 6 – Has an existing tenant which will move to Bldg 10 so we can host our in-residence program here. We have rented space to UW AI with a reciprocal agreement to teach our students about AI and offer them real-world experience. They've already moved in. We'd also like to use this space for Independent Study projects.
  - o Building 1 – Avocado Daycare is the tenant
  - o Building 2 – Avocado Daycare is the tenant
- May 8<sup>th</sup>: Middle School New Family Welcome Event. We need volunteers to socialize with the parents and help guide the kids through the campus.

**3. Hospitality:**

- May 31<sup>st</sup> 11 – 2 PM: All-school Picnic (Super Q) will include current families, new families, alums and staff. We'll offer many fun activities including a musical program, mural painting, sports and games. This will be a more casual version of Fall Harvest.
- Working on food, décor, activities for kids and parents, performances, etc.
